DESIGN BUILD CHALLENGE 2008

Design Build Challenge is an annual design and construction competition open to participants of all disciplines and levels of experience. The DBC is a fast-paced, *three day event* encouraging built responses to community needs in designated cities.

CHALLENGE

The DBC '08 focuses on various marginalized communities within Seattle that are currently facing issues of displacement due to rapid urban redevelopment. Participants will be given a contact list of potential clients - organizations with a community design need - with whom teams will collaborate to develop a meaningful and appropriate design response. The DBC aims to emphasize craft, creative reuse, environmental awareness, and innovation in response to the needs of the displaced communities identified in this challenge.

We hope to attract competitors from all geographic locations and varied backgrounds, including students, professionals, and practitioners of multiple disciplines. Working as individuals or in teams of any size, participants will be challenged to:

- **Establish a working relationship with a client**
- **Prepare a design proposal for review**
- **Fund the design**
- **Construct the approved design**
- **Acquire critical feedback on the finished project from a select jury**

Teams will be asked to accomplish these goals within the given time of slightly under three days. Scope, program and budget may vary and is determined by individual project teams.

The challenge begins at **9 pm on Thursday, March 27th** and ends at **5 pm on Sunday, March 30th**.

All submitted work must be completed only within the time frame of the competition --no prior work is permitted. The jury begins reviewing projects at 6 pm on Sunday, March 30th.

Each team will be asked to submit an entry fee, which will support program organization and implementation. Entry fees and submission dates are as follows:

Liability Waiver and Indemnity

TILT / Project Locus

Design Build Challenge March 27 through 30, 2008

This Release and Waiver of Liability (the Release) executed on this _____ day of _____, 2008 by _____ (the Contestant) in favor of TILT / Project Locus, nonprofit corporations, and Partners, their directors, officers, employees, and agents.

The Contestant desires to compete in the Design Build Challenge 2008, an event organized by the Releasees, and engage in the activities related to being a contestant (the Activities). The Contestant understands that the Activities may include constructing and rehabilitating in and around residential and commercial buildings, constructing new buildings. The Contestant hereby freely, voluntarily, and without duress executes this Release under the following terms:

Release and Waiver. Contestant does hereby release and forever discharge and hold harmless the Releasees and their successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from Volunteer's Activities with the Releasees.

Contestant understands that this Release discharges the Releasees from any liability or claim that the Contestant may have against the Releasees with respect to any bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, or property damage that may result from Contestant's Activities with the Releasees, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or its officers, directors, employees, or agents or otherwise. Contestant also understands that the Releasees do not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health, or disability insurance in the event of injury or illness.

It is the policy of the Releasees that persons under the age of 18 not be allowed to enter the Design Build Challenge 2007 competition.

Medical Treatment. Contestant does hereby release and forever discharge the Releasees from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Contestant's Activities with the Releasees or with the decision by any representative or agent of the Releasees to exercise the power to consent to medical or dental treatment.

Assumption of Risk. Contestant understands that the Activities include work that may be hazardous (that is, that can cause serious physical injury or death) to the Contestant, including, but not limited to, construction, loading and unloading, and transportation to and from the work sites. Contestant agrees to work with full knowledge of the dangers and potential injuries involved. Contestant hereby expressly and specifically assumes the risk of injury or harm in the Activities and releases the Releasees from all liability for injury, illness, death, or property damage resulting from the Activities and/or Contestant's negligence. Contestant also agrees to indemnify the Releasees for any injury they cause another.

Insurance. Contestant understands that, except as otherwise agreed to by the Releasees in writing; the Releasees do not carry or maintain health, medical, or disability insurance coverage for any Contestant. Each Contestant is expected and encouraged to obtain his or her own medical or health insurance coverage.

Photographic Release. Contestant does hereby grant and convey unto the Releasees all right, title, and interest in any and all photographic images and video or audio recordings made by the Releasees during the Contestant's Activities with the Releasees, including, but not limited to, any royalties, proceeds, or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings.

1. The Aggregate Limit of \$2,000,000 provides the full \$100,000 AD&D coverage for up to 20 persons in a common accident. Higher limits up to \$10,000,000 are available for groups of 20 or more persons together and is included automatically when the additional premium on the Enrollment for 21 persons or more in the same group is paid.
2. For persons age 70 or over and certain children, The Accidental Death & Dismemberment Benefits are reduced to \$10,000.00 and there is no Disability Income Benefit.

Rate

\$2.00 per person per day with a medical limit of \$2,500 - or -
***\$2.55 per person per day with Optional "Overseas Only" medical coverage.**
(The entire group must enroll under the same plan).

Enrollment Procedure

To secure coverage, complete the form entitled Enrollment, Volunteer Missionary Insurance and return this along with your check for the premium made payable to: Adams & Associates International®. In computing the number of days, count the departure day as well as the day of return.

If coverage is being secured for a group, the group would be responsible for requiring all Volunteers to carry this insurance. In the event the entire group is not travelling on the same dates, please attach a separate sheet grouping the Volunteers by the dates they are traveling.
